



The Art of Marc Chagall: Paintings, Mosaics, Stained Glass An Art Excursions Slide Lecture

This November the famous "Chagall Windows" will return to the galleries of The Art Institute of Chicago after a five-year absence. To mark this occasion, this program examines the career of Marc Chagall, one of the world's most beloved artists. Art historian and professor Dr. Michelle Paluch-Mishur discusses Chagall's distinctive style and his major themes. Going beyond the "Windows," Dr. Paluch-Mishur presents many important paintings and projects Chagall completed including another Chicago favorite -- the Four Seasons Mosaic.

Dr. Michelle Paluch-Mishur is co-owner of Art Excursions, a company that provides private guiding in Chicago; lectures; and boutique art and culture tours in the United States. A popular speaker about art historical and travel topics, she holds a Ph.D. in art history and has done extensive research about Chagall's work.
