



Lorenzo Ghiberti: Renaissance Sculptor

In the fifteenth century, Lorenzo Ghiberti revolutionized Italian sculpture by producing works such as the bronze doors for the Baptistry of the Cathedral of Florence. Ghiberti labored on these "Gates of Paradise" for twenty-seven years.

In this program, Dr. Michelle Paluch-Mishur, Ph.D. will discuss the history of the Gates of Paradise project and Ghiberti's contributions to Italian sculpture. She will also place Ghiberti and the project within the historical context of fifteenth century Florence.
