



A Gold Medal Collection of Art: London's National Gallery An Art Excursions Slide Lecture

London's National Gallery of Art displays one of the world's greatest collections of paintings and sculptures. In honor of the city's recent hosting of the summer Olympics, art historian Jeff Mishur discusses highlights of the gallery's collection including works by Jan van Eyck, Georges Seurat, Leonardo da Vinci, Peter Paul Rubens, Rembrandt, Vincent van Gogh, Jan Vermeer, Paul Cezanne, and Caravaggio.
