



Millennium Park: Chicago's Cultural Centerpiece

This slide lecture features a discussion of the history of Chicago's epic Millennium Park project and some of its central features including: the Frank O. Gehry-designed Jay Pritzker Pavilion and BP Bridge; Anish Kapoor's "Cloud Gate" (aka "The Bean") sculpture; Jaume Plensa's Crown Fountain; and the Lurie Garden designed by the team of Kathryn Gustafson, Piet Oudolf and Robert Israel. This program places certain elements of the park in the context of other recent projects undertaken by its contributors, including Gehry's Walt Disney Concert Hall.
