Due to their intense psychological insight, works by Edvard Munch (1863-1944) resonate with contemporary viewers as much as ever. In this slide lecture, art historian Dr. Michelle Paluch-Mishur will discuss Munch's intriguing artistic vision through a study of paintings and prints that relate closely to his biography. She will survey Munch's major themes and explain how relationships during his formative affected his approach to various subjects. Dr. Paluch-Mishur will also discuss how this pioneer of expressionism explored the human condition through haunting imagery.
