

The Art of Sports: Images of Athletes in Action

Whereas artists are often thought of as sedentary, the subject of sport has captivated painters and sculptors since the time of Ancient Greece. In this slide lecture, art historian Jeff Mishur looks at depictions of athletes in two-dimensional and three-dimensional artwork. Rather than attempt to cover depictions of every type of sport, Mishur's selection of material represents a broad range of style from realism to abstraction and from the 5th century BCE up through the modernist period.

Jeff Mishur is the owner of Art Excursions, a business that provides small group tours throughout the United States as well as lectures and private guiding in the Chicago area. Mishur has his M.A. in Art History from Northern Illinois University and has taught at the university level for many years.
