American painter Andrew Wyeth passed away in January 2009 at the age of 91. This slide lecture offers an overview of a career that lasted seven decades.

Rather than focusing on over-publicized subjects like the "Helga" pictures or "Christina's World" (although both will be discussed), this slide lecture concentrates on the themes of domestic interiors; architecture; intimate and panoramic landscapes; friends and family; and still-life subjects.
